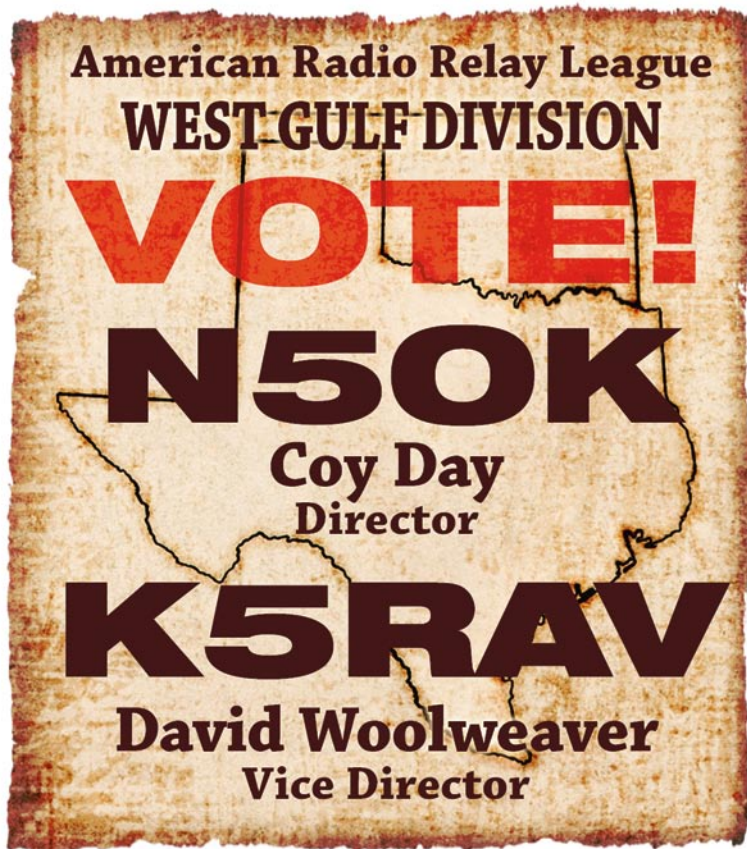

## The future of Ham Radio

is darkened by hostile antenna ordinances, prohibitive homeowner association restrictions, encroachment on dedicated spectrum by governmental and commercial interests and BPL.

Instead of being reactive, Ham Radio must change course and be proactive - we must seek passage of ordinances and legislation that eliminate homeowner association antenna restrictions and governmental restrictive antenna height limitations.

Too many of us are prohibited, or limited, from enjoying our great hobby by these thoughtless and outdated deed restrictions that prohibit, in defiance of PRB-1, the erection of reasonable antennas. We believe a coordinated and persistent legislative effort can obtain passage of Ham friendly bills that will establish minimal antenna heights and remove prohibitive deed covenants. The passage of such legislation will be one of our principal goals, if we are reelected.
